Dear South Bend High School students and families,

Welcome back to school for the 2021-2022 school year! We are thrilled to welcome all students back, five days a week, for in-person instruction. Staff are working hard to prepare classrooms and ensure our building is ready to meet our educational and safety needs.

Our first day back to school will be Wednesday, September 1, for students in grades 7-12. School starts at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:14 p.m. every day. Doors to campus open at 8 a.m.

Registration/Back To School Night Information

- Registration for **Juniors and Seniors** is Tuesday, August 24th, from 8-3:30 in the high school office.
- Registration for **Freshmen and Sophomores** is Wednesday, August 25th, from 8-3:30 in the high school office.
- Registration for **new students** is Monday 8/23 through Friday 8/27 from 8-3:30 in the high school office.
- “Back To School Night” for **7th and 8th graders** is Monday, 8/30, from 5-7 p.m. on the junior/senior high campus.

As we prepare for everyone’s safety, here are a few important details that pertain to our daily schedules and routines:

- All staff, students and visitors will be required to wear **face masks** while inside the building and while riding the bus.
- Masks can be removed while eating snacks and lunch.
- At this time, students will be expected to wear masks during **passing time and during time in the courtyard** during lunchtime after eating.
- All staff and students will need to complete the **Health Screening** each morning before entering the building. Families will have the opportunity to complete the survey online/via text, or students will be screened at the entrances to the building.
- Classroom seating will be arranged to allow **3 feet distancing**, to the best degree possible.
- **Lockers (HS students) and “Cubbies” (JH students)** will be available for students to store books, etc., but students will not be allowed to hang out in the locker rooms/cubbie locations any longer than it takes to get their books.
