

Pacific Community Foundation Scholarship Application Guidelines:

Complete applications are *strongly recommended*.

To be considered complete, applications include the following documents:

- Completed PCF Cover Form (see page 2 of form)
- Copy of high school transcript
- Copy of college transcripts if also attending college (e.g. Running Start)
- Biographical statement and career plans
- Vita—one page resumé of your career objective, education, work experiences, additional experiences, credentials or licenses, and names of your references
- Copy of SAT score report
- Copy of ACT score report, if available
- Letters of Reference
- Completed anticipated budget and expenses for one year

Do not enclose your application in a report cover. Use a paper clip or small binder clip. Our committees receive digital copies via email, which means all pages must be unbound to scan. We toss the covers. If you are sending your application via email, please use PDF format.

Submit a complete packet for each scholarship you are applying for.

These guidelines and associated forms are used for the following scholarships:

- Silent Key Scholarship (STEM only, includes Bachelor of Science programs in medicine and veterinary medicine)—All high schools
- Janet Mack Wilson Scholarship (STEM only, includes Bachelor of Science programs in medicine and veterinary medicine)—only Raymond and South Bend high schools
- Carol Peterson Schwartz Scholarship—all high schools, for students in Nursing at Clatsop Community College.
